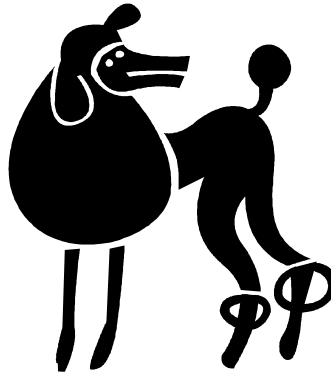

What's a Poodle Groomer?

A poodle groomer is a complexity dedicated to beautifying Poodles. She washes it, waves it, teases it, and combs it. She cuts it, conditions it, rinses it, shapes it, straightens it and sprays it – which naturally makes a poodle more beautiful. She's a Joan of Arc with sore feet, Florence Nightingale in a black uniform with brown fingernails. She's a business woman, a professional, a mother and a wife, she a psychiatrist, psychologist and psychoanalyst- adviser to the poodle owners, tax consultant, dog counsellor and just plain friend. She can always squeeze in just one more poodle, but is constantly ½ an hour behind her booking schedule. Her lunch hour is 8 minutes, usually spent on phone selling puppies or organising her next show. For lunch she has coffee and occasionally a doughnut. She works Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday and attends Dog Shows on her day off. In her salon she is a stylist, financial wizard, cleaning Lady,

stock clerk, receptionist, purchasing agent and very very tired. Sometimes marriage and a family take her away from her profession, but wait 'til those children grow up a little and she is back in the salon, behind her grooming table, doing the things she loves best.

TO HER, GROOMING IS JUST NOT A JOB- IT'S AN EMOTION!

Although she is paid for her services, her greatest reward comes when her client looks and caresses her new Poodle and says-

“I LOVE IT”
